DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The St. Catharines Rowing Club (SCRC) Board of Directors which consists of 15 volunteers is responsible for providing strategic direction, establishing policies, and overseeing the operation of the Club. The Directors constitute a 'working' board and meet monthly, establish several committees that are tasked with developing and recommending policies, oversee the management of club finances, assets and programs, and work cooperatively for the benefit of the Club members.

TERM OF OFFICE

Directors are elected for a three-year term at the Annual Meeting of Members and serve without remuneration.

TIME COMMITMENT

In addition to attending the Annual Meeting, Directors are expected to prepare for and participate in monthly meetings of the Board and represent the Club at a variety of events. From among the Directors, the Board elects officers, who have additional role-specific duties including President, V.P. Rowing, V.P. Finance, V.P. Membership, V.P. Fundraising, V.P. Special Projects, Secretary, and Treasurer. Each director is normally assigned to at least one portfolio/committee.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must be eighteen years of age or older, not bankrupt nor found incapable of managing property by a court. If elected to the Board and not already a member of the St. Catharines Rowing Club, Directors must become a Club member within 10 days of the election.

To be considered for nomination by the Nominating Committee, please complete the nomination form, include a statement outlining your interest in standing for election to the Board of Directors (100 words max.) and include a short biography (100 words max.). The completed form is to be emailed to Michelle Kerr, Chair of the Nominating Committee by November 20, 2023.
