GRANT APPLICATIONS:

SERVICE CANADA – SUMMER EMPLOYMENT GRANT:

After a disappointment in 2015, we were successful in being awarded this grant in 2016. The grant contributed to the salary of Ryan Malcowski who worked as Mark's assistant during the summer. I wish to acknowledge the assistance of Josh from the office of Chris Bittle MP for his assistance in tracking the information re this grant. We have submitted our application for a 2017 grant.

ONTARIO TRILLIUM FOUNDATION: We were successful and extremely fortunate to be awarded a Capital Grant of \$110,000 by the Ontario Trillium Foundation for the purchase of four new doubles and two new quads. These beautiful new boats were delivered to the boathouse on December 21 by Hudson Boatworks. This brings our total of capital grants from Trillium to \$200,000 since our first grant in 2007. The boats will be christened at the Annual Boat Christening on Sunday June 25, 2017.

ONTARIO – SUMMER EXPERIENCE PROGRAM: For the second consecutive year we were successful in being awarded a grant of \$2730.00 by the Ontario Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport, Summer Experience Program (SEP) to fund the salary of the Assistant to the Head Instructor, Youth Rowing School. We plan to apply for this grant again for 2017.
